SUBJECT: **STUDENT DIRECTORY INFORMATION**

The District shall publish an annual public notice informing parents or eligible students of their right to refuse the release of student directory information and indicating a time period for their response. Following such public notice and a reasonable response period, the District may release such information to an outside group without individual consent.

In accordance with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), directory information shall include the student's name, address, land line telephone listing, photograph, date and place of birth, major field of study, grade level, dates of attendance, enrollment status (e.g. undergraduate or graduate), full time or part-time status, dates of attendance, participation in officially-recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, degrees, honors and awards received, and the most recent educational agency or institution attended.
